TD Canada Trust Agricultural Services have now obtained the naming rights to the Classic therefore the show will now be called the “TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic”. They will continue to partner with Kubota Canada, Semex Alliance and Holstein Canada as sponsors to the youth shows at the Royal. A new logo is being developed and will be available for all groups to use.

Attached is the 2011 entry form. Deadline for entries is Tuesday, October 11th. Early entries are definitely encouraged. Entries can be faxed to 519-653-2129 or sent to the Ontario Holstein Branch office. If you require further information regarding TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic then go to www.royalfair.org and under the Competition Book you will see a link to the TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic. A Chaperone Agreement is also attached, which must be completed and sent in as well.

STAGERED MOVE IN TIME – Due to a heavy beef schedule with the Royal, 290 of the TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic participants will be allowed to move in on Saturday, November 5th between the times of 10am and 2pm. The remaining 80 participants will move in after 8pm on Saturday, November 5th meaning that we would like to have groups volunteer to come in at that time or else we will designate what groups will come in later. Beef 4-H members will be moving in earlier in the morning and we ask you to please respect the times given and not move in earlier. On Saturday, we are to only use the north wash rack.

Out of province groups will still be allowed to move in on Friday and you are to contact Bert Stewart (519-846-8052) prior to move in on the time that you will be arriving.

The chaperone and one 4-H'er from each group are expected to attend a meeting on Sunday afternoon at 3:00 p.m in Salon 103 in the Trade Centre. Rules and Regulations for the show will be discussed including the measurement of topline hair.

Stall cards will be emailed to each contact this year to allow for ease of putting information on the cards regarding the calf and the participant. We ask that all cards be printed off in the format that was sent to you.

New show shirts will be handed out at the Registration table on Saturday afternoon. For groups moving in later, please come to the TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic office to register your team as soon as possible.
