### **SHOW GUIDELINES**

- This is an **OPEN SHOW** and there are no restrictions on the number of entries per exhibitor.
- **ENTRY DEADLINE: Tuesday, October 11<sup>th</sup>, 2011.**
- **ENTRY FEE: \$20.00** per animal (includes HST). Entries received after October 11<sup>th</sup> are allowed at a **\$25.00** entry fee per animal. Any dishonored cheques are subject to a \$50.00 service charge fee.
- **ARRIVAL TIMES: MONDAY, October 17<sup>TH</sup>, 7:00 a.m. – TUESDAY, October 18<sup>TH</sup>, 8:00 p.m. Bedding on Sunday by appointment only.**
- All animals must be identified with **STALL CARDS**. Exhibitors are responsible for supplying their own stall cards.
- Separate stabling is available for **C.H.A.H.** and **LEUCOSIS FREE HERDS**. Please indicate this on your entry form.
- Exhibitors are reminded to update required health care and inoculations against communicable diseases. **ANY ANIMAL SHOWING OBVIOUS SIGNS OF RINGWORM MUST PROVIDE A VETERINARY CERTIFICATE.**
- **SHOW HARNESES** will be used. Exhibitors must provide their own.
- **REGISTRATION PAPERS** must accompany animals to the show. Photocopies are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- Exhibitors must provide their own feed and hay.
- **MANURE REMOVAL** is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Follow signs posted to designated manure disposal areas. **Please keep manure free of garbage.**
- **No removal of any fixtures or Fairground property i.e. rings or bolts from erected stabling.**

**IN THE EVENT of any dispute or violation of show guidelines, the show committee reserves the right to not pay any prize money and may ask the exhibitor to leave the grounds.**

- The **BRED & OWNED** award will be presented to the animal whose breeder, as defined by the prefix, is the owner or co-owner of that animal.
- **PREMIER BREEDER Banner** will be presented to the **breeding unit** (individual, partnership or institution) having the highest number of points won in individual female classes by not more than 10 animals bred, but not necessarily owned by the winner. In the case of jointly owned animals, a **joint breeding is considered as one breeding unit**. No part of the points awarded counts toward the individual score of any of the joint breeders.
- **PREMIER EXHIBITOR banner** will be presented to the **exhibitor/owner** (individual, partnership or institution) having the highest number of points won in individual female classes by not more than 10 animals owned by the exhibitor. This does not limit the number of animals that may be shown. In the case of jointly owned animals, joint ownership is considered as one exhibitor. No part of the points awarded counts toward the individual score of any of the joint owners.

- **4-H ENTRIES:** To be recognized as a 4-H calf, the entry must be the 2011 project of the leadsperson and the 4-H member's name must be on the entry form.

Each exhibitor shall hold the show management blameless for any loss or accident while on the grounds. It shall also be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall be responsible for any injury or damage that may befall any person, personal article or animal while at the Autumn Opportunity Holstein show in 2011. It is the responsibility and condition of entry that each exhibitor must carry liability insurance. Please confirm coverage with your insurance company. All trucking to and from the show is the responsibility of the exhibitor or purchaser.
