

# Chaperone Agreement

Canadian 4-H Classic Junior Dairy Show

November 5-7, 2011

**Purpose of a Chaperone:** To coach, mentor, and guide youth participants to have a safe, healthy, and positive learning experience through participation in the TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic.

## Basic Show Chaperone Requirements:

- A minimum of one chaperone will be designated for the county/regional/provincial team and must be 25 years of age before Jan. 1 of the current year.
- Each additional chaperone must be at least 21 years of age before Jan.1 of the current year.

## Chaperone Expectations:

- ✓ Abide by 4-H Canada policies and guidelines and model all rules and regulations for the participants (4-H and event rules).
- ✓ Attend the chaperone meeting on the Sunday afternoon.
- ✓ Supervise youth during the entire time of the event.
- ✓ Ensure youth actively participate in all activities
- ✓ Ensure any special health and safety needs of your group's participants
- ✓ Enforce behavior guidelines and code of conduct for the event and appropriately handle misbehavior.
- ✓ Assist with logistics of the event as appropriate
- ✓ Supervise Check In, Clean Up & Check Out
- ✓ Supervise youth including discipline, housing and health
- ✓ Enforce set curfews – notify participants in advance of curfew, inform participants that they must sleep in the room assigned so contact can be made if any emergency arises.
- ✓ Sleep in assigned areas to monitor the health and safety of participants.
- ✓ Complete any necessary reports
- ✓ Abide by all the rules and regulations set by the TD Canadian 4-H Dairy Classic Committee
