Groups are responsible for making their own hotel reservations. The hotel list is attached. Please note that there are two other conferences that are taking place during the Royal which will make it tough to get enough rooms if you do not book early. A shuttle service for competitors and chaperones will be provided by the RAWF from the two designated hotels only. ****Please Note**:**

- All Project Animals must be registered at least **75% Purity Level** with the Breed Association.
- In support of National Health and Bio-Security interest, **all calves of all breeds must be tagged** with dairy breed sanctioned National tags (NLID or RFID).
- Only 1 (one) project per 4-H member may be pre-registered for the Canadian 4-H Classic.

Pre-Registraion Guidelines

Every potential 4-H member that may be interested in competing in the 2011 Canadian 4-H Classic at the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair in November must complete PRE-REGISTRATION. The procedure is as follows:

All Provinces (EXCLUDING Ontario):

- The Provincial Canadian 4-H Classic Coordinator or the Provincial 4-H Supervisor will provide the Canadian 4-H Classic Committee with a listing of all bonafide 4-H calves and members with a 2011 4-H Dairy Calf project.
- Quebec, please separate and clearly mark each of the six designated regions.
- A Pre-Registration Form is attached for out-of-province. If more convenient, you maybe provide a copy of the registration form that is used to register 4-H projects in your province. All Pre-Registration forms must be forwarded to the Ontario Holstein Branch **before June 17th, 2011.** Please send all completed pre-registration forms from your province, region, district or county in one envelope.

In Ontario

- A 4-H Ontario Project Identification Form (PAI) – Dairy must be completed and forwarded to the 4-H coordinator prior to June 1st, 2011. Please ensure that all information is included. Only one (1) calf project per 4-H member may be pre-registered.
- Please note that the Canadian 4-H Classic check box on the PAI has been removed. Any child 12 and over is considered pre-registered if their form is to 4-H Ontario by June 1, 2011.
- Your Ontario Provincial Coordinator (listed below) will be responsible for submitting pre-registration forms to the Ontario Holstein Branch.
- All Ontario pre-registration information is to be collected by a county representative and forwarded the Provincial Co-Ordinator, in one envelope:
