This show is open to all dairy calf club members 9-13 years of age, as of January 1, 2011, who are registered as 4-H members in the counties of East-Central Ontario Holstein District. This show is designed as an educational and fun event. Our goal is to make the activities hands on, practical.

1. Calves, 4-H'ers and chaperones to arrive at the Orono Fairgrounds between noon and 2:00 p.m. on Monday, July 4.
2. Calf must be the 2011 calf project of the 4-H member. Substitutes allowed if calf is sick, please let organizers know ASAP.
3. CALVES **MUST BE CLIPPED** EXCEPT FOR THE TOPLINE PRIOR TO ARRIVAL AT THE FAIRGROUNDS. The organizing committee will have fitters available to assist the contestants to complete the topline of the calf.
4. 4-H members will have stall cards provided to identify the calf and 4-H member.
5. All calves must have plastic Panel NLID tag.
6. Full Whites and appropriate footwear are required for showmanship and conformation classes.
7. Straw and Shavings will be provided by the committee.
8. Meals will be provided for all contestants and chaperones.
9. Health and Safety forms need to be collected from each participant. It can be a copy of the original sent into 4-H Ontario.
